AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 not to harass the petitioners at the instance of respondent No.4 as the petitioners have married against the wishes of private respondents, with further prayer to direct the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners as well as the family members of petitioner No.2.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioners will be satisfied if Senior Superintendent of Police, District Bathinda, Punjab i.e. respondent No.2 is directed to look into the representation dated 17.05.2023 (Annexure P-6), made to him by the petitioners in this regard and take appropriate action on the same.

3. As per averments made in the petition, both the petitioners are major. Dates of birth of both the petitioners are 09.03.2004 and 10.05.1994, respectively. Copies of their Aadhar cards are appended with the petition as Annexures P1 and P2, respectively. They got married on 17.05.2023 as per Marriage Certificate, Annexure P-4. Photographs of the marriage are Annexure P-5.

4. Notice of motion.
5. At the asking of the Court, Mr. M.S. Nagra, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and has no objection in deciding the representation filed on behalf of the petitioners.
6. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and without going into the merits of the claim raised by the petitioners, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 17.05.2023 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.
