2. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, for grant of parole to the petitioner under Sections 3 and 4 of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962, for a period of 45 days.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner had moved a representation dated 27.04.2023 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.3-Superintendent, New District Jail Nabha. But till date no decision has been taken on the said representation.

5. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents No. 1 to 3.

Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-Superintendent, New District Jail Nabha, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 27.04.2023 (Annexure P-1); to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
