Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 10.11.2022 (Annexure P-6) of petitioners and to consider the case of petitioner for granting her full pension w.e.f. April 2016.

Learned counsel for the respondents-PSPCL refers to the letter No.6451 dated 07.08.2023 of the Senior Executive Engineer Operations Division, Bhogpur and submits that as per RPPO No.165297 dated 01.06.2023 payment of an amount of Rs.4,86,788/- towards arrears has been made in the pension for the month of 06/2023 and as per PPO No.156690 dated 20.12.2022 payment of Rs.39,692/- has been made in the month of 12/2022 and payment of Rs.18,332/- towards arrear has been made in the pension for the month of 02/2023. He further submits that the widow i.e. the petitioner is being paid monthly family pension amounting to Rs.12,536/- as per RPPO No.165297 dated 01.06.2023.

The aforesaid fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner and prays for withdrawal of the present writ petition.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is hereby dismissed as
withdrawn.
