In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that though, he is entitled for the grant of benefit of compassionate appointment after the death of his father but the said benefit is not being extended to him by the respondents.

As per the averments made in the present petition, the respondent-department has given a statement before this Court in CWP-10753-1993 titled as **Ram Mehar vs. MITC** that as and when a post will occur, the claim of the petitioner will be considered but no benefit of appointment has been given to the petitioner so far and that too without any valid justification. Prayer of the petitioner is that an appropriate direction be issued to the respondents to give a compassionate appointment to the petitioner with respondent No.3-Corporation or with any other department.

A bare perusal of the pleadings shows that for claiming the said

benefit, the petitioner has not approached the department or Corporation prior to the filing of the present petition hence, the interest of justice will be served, in case the petitioner is directed to raise the said claim, as raised in the present petition first before the respondents and respondents are directed that in case any such claim, as raised in the present petition, is raised by the the petitioner before them, the same be decided within a period of 08 weeks from date of receipt of any such claim. In case, the petitioner is aggrieved against the decision of the respondents, he will be free to avail an appropriate remedy.

Present petition stands disposed of with the above observations.
