The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing entire investigation against the petitioner in case FIR No. 13 dated 02.11.2020 registered under Sections 409, 420, 465, 466, 467, 471 and 120 B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Section 7, 7 (a) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, FS-1, SAS Nagar, Mohali (Annexure P-1).

After arguing vehemently at length, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedy available to him in accordance with law.
