1. In the present petition, the prayer of the petitioners is that they are entitled for the grant of pensionary benefits under the old pension scheme keeping in view the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in CWP No.2371 of 2010 titled as ***Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others***, decided on 31.08.2010 but the benefit of the said judgment is not being extended to the petitioners, which is causing prejudice to them.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance in the representation (Annexure P-10) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage, in case a direction is issued to the respondents to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that in case, the representation (Annexure P-10) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
