The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India by the petitioner for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to provide an electricity connection to the petitioner's house.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 has made a specific statement on 14.09.2021 to the effect that the demand has been revised and the same was deposited by the petitioner and electric connection pursuant thereto has since been released. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on that date.

Today also, learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 on instructions from Satinder Singh SDO City Kharar, submits that electricity connection has already been released. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of as having been rendered

infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to seek revival of this petition if any cause of action still survive.
