The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* seeking direction to the respondents to release the retiral benefits with all the consequential benefit.

Learned State counsel submits that all the dues, as have been claimed in the instant petition stand released in favour of the petitioner on 26.08.2023, as is evident from a letter produced today to that effect. The said letter addressed to the Advocate General, Haryana is taken on record, as produced by learned State counsel.

In light of the above, nothing survives in the present petition. Hence, the petition stands disposed of, as having been rendered infructuous.

However, it is made clear that petitioner will be at liberty to get the petition revived, if any grievance is left out to be addressed.
