ANOOP CHITKARA, J.

The petitioner has come up before this Court seeking quashing of the impugned order dated 03.02.2018 passed by the Special Judge, Ludhiana (Annexure P-6) in case FIR No.5 dated 23.03.2007 registered under Sections 409, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 201, 120-B IPC and Sections 7, 8, 9, 13(1)(C)(D) r/w Section 13(2), 14 of Prevention of Corruption Act at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Ludhiana, whereby the application moved by the petitioner seeking permission to join the proceedings at the time of consideration of cancellation report submitted under Section 173(8) CrPC in the aforesaid FIR, has been dismissed.

2. Counsel for the State on instructions submits that the cancellation report has been accepted in the year 2019 and despite that the petitioner is unnecessarily delaying this matter.

3. Since the cancellation report has already been accepted and interlocutory order has merged in final order, as such, no further orders are required to pass in the present petition and the same is disposed of accordingly. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of. Liberty reserved to the petitioner to challenge the final order of acceptance of cancellation report or to file a private complaint if he is aggrieved person/victim.
