The present application has been filed with the prayer that hearing of the main case may kindly be preponed from 12.10.2023 to an early actual date.

For the reasons stated in the application, the same is allowed and on joint request of counsel appearing for the parties, main case is taken up for hearing today itself.

CWP No.14912 of 2021

The present petition has been filed with the prayer that the petitioners, who were selected against the post of Conductor, are entitled for appointment, keeping in view that certain candidates, who though were higher in merit than the petitioners but have not joined the post and the petitioners being next in waiting list should be given appointment.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that though notice of motion was already issued by Coordinate Bench of this Court on 06.08.2021 and two years have passed, but respondents have not chosen to file the reply, which is causing prejudice to petitioners, hence, the petitioners will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is given to the respondents to decide their representations, which have been filed by the petitioners, copies of which have been appended as Annexures P-12 to P-14 so that the petitioners do not suffer any further prejudice.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the representations (Annexure P-12 to P-14) have not been already decided, the same will be decided within a period of eight weeks from today by passing an appropriate speaking order and in case, any benefit accrues to the petitioners after passing the speaking order, the same will be extended to them within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
