Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to official respondents to take legal action against private respondents/accused in FIR No. 123, dated 04.08.2018, registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act (Sections 302 IPC added vide roznamcha (daily diary) No. 28 dated 07.08.2018 at Police Station Islamabad, Commissionerate, District Amritsar.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jagjit Singh submits that all co-accused have already been arrested and are facing trial. He further submits that 8 prosecution witnesses have already been examined and now next date of hearing in the trial Court is 17.04.2023.
