Kashmir Singh Vs. Dharamvir etc.

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Vide order dated 20.03.2022, on the basis of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, this Forum had disposed of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.1,50,000/- in the name of appellant-Kashmir Singh, and thereafter the said cheque was issued in the name of Kashmir Singh but now it has been revealed by learned counsel for the appellant that the said Kashmir Singh had since died on 02.08.2019. Thereafter, learned counsel for the appellant had filed an application before this Hon'ble High Court for bringing on record the legal heirs of the appellant-Kashmir Singh. The said application was allowed and the LRs of the deceased were ordered to be brought on record, subject to just exceptions.

A note has been put up by the office for issuance of a fresh cheque in the name of LRs of the deceased-appellant.

Notice of the application be issued but now Mr. Sandeep Suri, accepts notice on behalf of the National Ins. Co. Ltd.

Accordingly, National Ins. Co. Ltd.-respondent No.3 is directed to issue a fresh cheque in the name of Simarjit Kaur on or before 25.11.2023

Copy of this order along with earlier original Cheque No.131489 dated 30.03.2023 be supplied/returned to learned counsel for the Insurance Company.
