The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.0017 dated 14.05.2022 registered under Sections 324, 323, 379-B, 427, 148 and 149 of IPC (Sections 326 and 307 IPC added later on vide DRR No.32 on 16.05.2022 and DDR No.15 dated 24.05.2022 respectively) at Police Station Nangal Bhoor, District Pathankot.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 27.07.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. He submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surinder Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case. However, he submits that *Dattar* has not been recovered from the petitioner.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 27.07.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
