This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent No.2 to decide the petition filed by the present petitioner under Section 8 read with Section 12 of the Punjab Privately Managed Recognised Schools Employees (Security of Service) Act, 1979 expeditiously preferably in the time bound manner and to comply with the order dated 06.07.2017 (Annexure P-2) issued by respondent No.2.

Vide order dated 05.07.2023, learned State counsel was directed to complete his instructions with regard to order dated 16.07.2019 passed by respondent No.2 i.e., Education Tribunal Punjab. Learned counsel further submits that since the Coram was not complete and Tribunal was not functioning. As per instructions, learned State counsel submits that now the

Coram is complete and the Chairman has been appointed, the case is fixed for arguments before the Education Tribunal, Punjab.

In view of the abovesaid position, nothing remains to be adjudicated and the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to take all the pleas before the Education Tribunal, Punjab for redressal, where the matter is already pending.
