Short reply by way of an affidavit of Superintendent, District Jail, Rohtak dated 27.05.2023 has been filed, which is taken on record.

2. This petition has been filed for granting parole to the petitioner in case FIR No.105 dated 18.08.2013, registered under Section 376 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station Mohana, Rohtak, for two weeks on account of his sisters' marriage fixed for 05.06.2023.

3. Learned State counsel submits that the alleged representation dated 15.05.2023, Annexure P-5, seeking parole was never received by the respondents. The petitioner had only moved an application dated 19.05.2023, Annexure R-2, for temporary release on furlough for three weeks. The application has been forwarded to the District Magistrate on 24.05.2023 and is under consideration. Appropriate action thereupon will be taken in due course. By referring to the short reply, she further submits that the petition has been filed on false averments that marriage of the

petitioner’s real sister is to be solemnized on 05.06.2023. As per verification report of the SHO concerned, that the ladies, who are getting married on 05.06.2023, are petitioner’s cousins, and not real sisters.

- 4. In view thereof, there is no ground to entertain the petition.
