By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the relief of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.20 dated 03.04.2023 registered at Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa, under Sections 452, 354 and 323 IPC.

2. Learned State counsel, on the instructions from HC Swaraj Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on 22.05.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and moreover, he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel as well as the fact that vide the said order dated 22.05.2023, the Co-ordinate Bench has already granted the interim relief to the petitioner by

way of staying his arrest subject to his joining in the investigation, the petition in hand is allowed to the effect that the petitioner is extended the concession of anticipatory bail subject to his furnishing the requisite personal as well as surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.

5. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
