1. Prayer in the petition is for quashing impugned order Annexure P/1 dated 10.03.2023, passed by respondent No.3, rejecting the claim of the petitioner for grant of parole in view of the provisions of Section 6(3) of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022 (for short 'the Act').

2. After arguing for some time, learned for the petitioner states that in view of the objection of the State of the petitioner not being entitled to be released on parole in view of the provisions of Section 6(3) of the Act, on account of his being a hardcore prisoner and having been convicted for violation of conditions of parole/furlough on 03.04.2021, he does not press the instant petition and prays for permission to withdraw the same.

3. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
