1. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has instructions that the Enquiry Officer has completed the enquiry during the pendency of this Writ Petition and in terms of the orders passed by this Court, no final order has been taken by the respondents. He further informs that the enquiry was concluded in the year 2021.

2. Keeping in view that the enquiry has been concluded by the concerned Enquiry Officer, the respondents are expected to take a decision at the earliest. In fact, time schedule for completing the enquiry should not be more than 10 months. However, it appears that even after the Enquiry Officer has submitted his report, the respondents have not taken any final decision on the same. It is directed that respondents shall take decision on the enquiry report and of course, before doing so, a copy of the enquiry report shall be made available to the petitioner. The respondents are expected to decide and conclude the enquiry within a period of one month hereinafter.

3. With the said observations, the interim order passed by this Court earlier stands modified. The Writ Petition is disposed of in the aforementioned terms.

4. All the pending applications in this Writ Petition stand disposed of accordingly.
