The petitioner prays for issuance of a direction to the respondents to appoint her son on compassionate grounds. She claims that her husband is bed ridden and therefore, forcibly sought voluntary retirement, which was allowed.

Despite repeated requests from the Court, the learned counsel representing the petitioner has failed to draw the attention of the Court to any such instructions, which enable the children of the employees, who have already retired voluntarily, to seek compassionate appointment.

In view of the aforesaid facts, no ground to issue the writ, as prayed for, is made out.

Hence, dismissed.
