Petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR bearing No.93 dated 09.07.2014, under Sections 420/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur (Annexure P-4), charge-sheet order dated 17.05.2016 passed by the Court of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Moonak (Annexure P-6) and order dated 29.11.2016 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur (Annexure P-8).

On instructions from ASI Gamdoor Singh, learned State counsel submits that in terms of judgment dated 17.02.2023, petitioner No.1 has been acquitted by the trial Court. Petitioner No.2 has died on 23.07.2021 and Kewal Krishan, non-applicant has been convicted under Section 420 IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of 03 years. Consequently, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has not disputed the aforesaid factual aspects.

In these set of circumstances, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
