Prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR in question and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise, arrived at between the parties.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Jaiteshwar S. Bhandari, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1-State.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the notice was effected on 29.04.2020 and on the expiry of 30 days, proclamation order was passed. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is ready to present himself before the concerned Court. However, he should be protected from being arrested.

I have considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the provision of Section 71 of Cr.P.C., the petitioner is allowed to move appropriate application for conversion of the non

bailable warrants and the concerned Magistrate shall consider all the aspects and pass suitable orders.
