Prayer in this 2nd petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in cross-case i.e. DDR No.16 dated 24.03.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran in FIR No.57 dated 13.03.2018 registered under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

The earlier one was disposed of vide order dated 03.06.2021, passed in CRM-M No.20466 of 2021, as it was stated by counsel for the petitioner that the petition be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court and the trial Court was directed to decide the same expeditiously on the same day.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that one week more time be granted to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ayush Sarna, AAG, Punjab who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State and has not raised any serious objection.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and apply for regular bail, the trial Court will dispose of the regular bail application of the petitioner on the same day.
