The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.93 dated 20.04.2023 registered under Sections 420, 465, 468, 471, 474 and 120-B at Police Station Phillaur, Jalandhar Rural, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.05.2023, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

An affidavit dated 17.07.2023 by way of an affidavit of Jagdish Raj, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Phillaur, District Jalandhar has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 22.05.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
