Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order declaring the petitioner as the proclaimed person stands no longer in existence as the complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act 1881 has been withdrawn. Thus, the FIR No.0059 dated 23.02.2023 registered at Police Station Barara District Ambala under Section 174-A of IPC, 1860, deserves to be quashed.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 admits that the complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act 1881 has been withdrawn.

Under the above circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by continuing with the FIR aforementioned.

Thus, the petition is allowed, FIR No.0059 dated 23.02.2023 registered at Police Station Barara District Ambala under Section 174-A of IPC, 1860 is quashed.
