While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed
on 22.05.2023:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a bona fide purchaser of the gold locket allegedly snatched by the main accused. He was not aware that the said item had been obtained by them after committing a crime. Being a goldsmith, the purchase was in course of regular business. The petitioner is willing to get the gold locket recovered.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Grewal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice and waives service.

Adjourned to 02.08.2023.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join investigation with the Investigating Officer on 01.06.2023 at 10.00 a.m. and cooperate therewith. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on

interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/SHO concerned subject to his compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is clarified that in case the gold locket purchased by him is not produced before the Investigating Officer on the date fixed, the concession of interim bail shall stand withdrawn.”

- 2. Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from IO Lal Singh, has stated that pursuant to the order dated 22.05.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.
- 3. In view of above, the interim order dated 22.05.2023 passed by this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as enumerated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
- 4. This petition stands disposed off.
