The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr. PC with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.62, dated 07.04.2023, under Sections 452,295-A,323, 294,427, 506, 148,149 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.05.2023 passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
