SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. Since the learned State counsel submits, that the Authority concerned, has in respect of illegal excavations of minor minerals being done, at the instance of co-respondent No.6, thus imposed a penalty quantified in a sum of Rs.72,65,269/-, upon, the said respondent.
2. Therefore, in view of the above, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks and is permitted to withdrawn the instant petition, the same for the above reason becoming rendered infructuous. Ordered accordingly.
3. However, co-respondents No.2 and 3 are directed to ensure, that hereafters no illegal excavations of minor minerals concerned, are made by co-respondent No.6, at the site concerned. If the said excavations are made, thereupon, liberty is reserved to co-respondents No.2 and 3 to draw such action, as deemed fit under law against co-respondent No.6.
4. Disposed of accordingly.
