The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing to respondent No.3 to release the pending payment of the petitioner that had been approved by the department on 08.01.2021.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 submits that there was a dispute between the partners of the firm for which they had filed a suit and that the payment remained pending on account of the inter se dispute between the partners.

The partners namely Pawan Kumar and Sumant Kumar (petitioner herein) filed an application alongwith undertaking stating therein that the matter has been amicably resolved between the partners and that as per the settlement, the payment can be claimed by the petitioner-Sumant Kumar. Pursuance to the said settlement and a letter of undertaking given by the partners, the payment of Rs.58,26,734/- have already been released to the petitioner on 10.08.2022 against the work done.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by the learned counsel for

respondents No.1 to 3 on the strength of the communication/Memo

No.MCF/FC/2022/1924 dated 14.10.2022, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
