1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking grant of post-arrest bail in:-

0229	18.11.2021	Baghapurana, District Moga	22 of NDPS Act (later on Section 25 of the NDPS Act was added)

2. Custody Certificate dated 05.07.2023 has been filed by the State, which is taken on record. Perusal of the Custody Certificate shows that the accused-petitioner, who is alleged to be in possession of commercial quantity (1100 tablets of *Tramadol* weighing 277.4 grams), has undergone a custody of one year and seven months.
