Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.250, dated 10.09.2022, registered at Police Station Bhondsi, District Gurugram, under Sections 364-A, 387, 506, 120-B/34 of IPC.

FIR was lodged on the complaint of Om Pal Singh, as per which his daughter Lavanya Singh was allegedly kidnapped on 09.09.2022. He received ransom call on his mobile demanding ₹50 lacs, otherwise it was threatened that his daughter will be killed. Complainant had also come to know that Jansi Tiwari, the daughter of the petitioner was also missing and in fact both the girls have been kidnapped. Police was informed. It is alleged that co-accused Sagar and Suraj left the kidnapped girls at Hero Honda Chowk. The daughter of the petitioner informed her that two uncles had taken them away.

The role attributed to the petitioner is that she was in conspiracy with the co-accused for getting daughter of the complainant kidnapped and in order to avoid any suspicion on her, she also got lifted her own daughter.

It is contended by counsel for the petitioner that allegations against petitioner are false; that no mother will take the risk of getting her own daughter kidnapped.

Be that as it may, petitioner was at the most the part of conspiracy, which is yet to be established. She did not participate in the crime. Petitioner is stated to be in custody since 10.09.2022.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Randhir Singh, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Facts pleaded by learned counsel for the petitioner are not refuted by him.

Having regard to the aforesaid facts and circumstances, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, petitioner is admitted to bail on her furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court concerned.
