Prayer in the instant petition is for setting aside the order dated 01.11.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by the lower Appellate Court, vide which a condition has been imposed that the sentence of the petitioner shall remain suspended subject to deposit of 25% of the compensation amount in the form of a Bank Draft within a period of 30 days.

Counsel for the petitioner has produced the order dated 11.01.2021 passed by the Court of Ld. Sessions Judge-cum-Presiding Officer, Daily Lok Adalat, Faridabad whereby on the basis of the compromise effected between the parties, the matters stands compounded and the impugned judgment of conviction and order of sentence has been set aside. He submits that in view of the said order, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
