1. It is averred on affidavit that, during the pendency of the instant writ petition before this Court, the demise of petitioner No.1 has occurred on 12.04.2021. Since his estate, as revealed in paragraph 2 of the application is inherited by his LR. Therefore, for ensuring the continuation of the lis on behalf of petitioner No.1 by his LR, the substitution of the deceased petitioner by his LR, as enumerated in paragraph 2 of the application rather is imperative.

2. Thus, the application is allowed, and, the applicant, as mentioned in paragraph 2 of the application is ordered to be impleaded as party-petitioner. The amended memo of parties is filed, and, the same is taken on record. The Registry of this Court is directed to tag the same at an

appropriate place.

3. No notice is required to be served to the newly added petitioners, as they stand represented through their counsel.
