As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel further submitted that Ravi Kumar-Appellant No.3 S/o Hari Singh-Appellant No.1 has expired and his offspring are being looked after by Hari Singh and thus, the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Hari Singh S/o Shri Lallu Ram, for & on behalf of all the claimants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.5,00,000/- favouring appellant No.1-Hari Singh S/o Shri Lallu Ram, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 20.07.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
