Challenge in the present writ petition, filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the re-allotment letter dated 03.02.2006 (Annexure P-10) which was executed in favour of the private respondent No.7 by respondent No.5 who is closely related to the petitioner being the sister.

2. Accordingly, we are of the considered opinion that the litigation by way of writ on the ground that there is a forgery and fabrication would not lie, being disputed question of facts and the jurisdiction would lie elsewhere.
