RAVI SHANKER JHA, CHIEF JUSTICE (Oral):

Though, this Court has already disposed of the petition, filed by the petitioner, previously, against an order of blacklisting, on the statement of the learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, that they would give an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and thereafter take a decision on its representation and pursuant to the said order as the respondents-authorities have already granted personal hearing to it and are in the process of deciding the matter and, therefore, the second petition for the same relief is not maintainable.

However, when confronted with the fact that after hearing the petitioner, no order has been passed on its representation, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, submits that the necessary order will be passed and communicated to the petitioner, as early as possible, preferably, within a period of one week.

In these circumstances, taking the statement of learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, on record, and in terms thereof, the petition stands disposed of.
