On 18.04.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ The petitioner has sought quashing of order dated 13.10.2010 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned JMIC, Batala whereby he was declared as proclaimed offender in case FIR No.133 dated 20.12.2009 registered under Sections 420, 506, 120-B IPC at PS Qadian, Batala.

Counsel for the petitioner submitted that at the time of registration of FIR, he was not available in India and even now the petitioner is permanent resident of Mexico. He further contended that the civil suit filed by the complainant with regard to disputed amount has also been dismissed vide judgment dated 10.3.2015 (Annexure P-4) wherein also, it was recorded that at the relevant time, the petitioner was residing in America.

Now be listed on 14.12.2022.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear

before the trial Court and on his appearance, he is ordered to be released on interim bail by the said Court to its own satisfaction till the next date of hearing fixed in the present petition.”

The Counsel for the petitioner states that in deference to the aforesaid order the petitioner has surrendered himself before the Trial Court and has since been released on interim bail.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is expected that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and not absent himself from the proceedings without sufficient cause. The petitioner is also directed to surrender his passport immediately before the Trial Court.
