1. The present writ petition has been filed seeking to challenge the impugned order dated 10.05.2022 (Annexure P-5) by which petitioner has been awarded the punishment of stoppage of two increments with cumulative effect and the order dated 02.05.2023 (Annexure P-7) by which his statutory appeal was dismissed, by contending that both the orders are non-speaking orders.

2. Notice of motion.

3. At this stage, Ms. Nikita Goel, Advocate, has caused appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondents. She, on instructions, would submit that fresh order would be passed by the Managing Director, UHBVNL-respondent No.1 and thereafter, in case the petitioner, still having a grievance, files an appeal with the Chairman, the same would be considered in accordance with law.

4. Let adequate number of copies of the writ petition be furnished to the counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents during the course of the day.
5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have perused both the impugned orders, which in the opinion of this Court are totally non-speaking. It would be expected that the petitioner herein should be made aware of the grounds as to why there is a punishment imposed upon him.
6. In view of the fair statement given that fresh orders would be passed, the orders 10.05.2022 and 02.05.2023 (Annexures P-5 and P-7 respectively) are hereby set aside leaving it open to the authorities concerned to pass fresh orders.
7. Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
