The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.481 dated 01.12.2022 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 120-B of the IPC, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Chandhut, Palwal, District Palwal.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 25.05.2023, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 25.05.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
