Prayer made in the present petition was for setting aside the order dated 13.04.2019/18.04.2019 (Annexure P-10) whereby the request of the petitioner for release of electricity connection had been declined.

Written statement on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 has been filed wherein it has been averred that as per the latest report made by the concerned Junior Engineer of the area on 22.03.2023, no such shop is existing in the property mentioned and the same has been vacated and demolished thereafter.

It is thus averred that the present petition has been rendered infructuous for want of the premises where the electricity

connection was to be released.

A written request for adjournment has been moved on behalf of the counsel for the petitioner who is stated to be unwell. However, Ms. Sumitra, Advocate appears on behalf of Mr. Sandeep Kumar, Advocate for the petitioner.

Taking into consideration a specific stand of the respondent that the shop already stands demolished and is no more in existence at the spot. The present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present petition, in case the aforesaid averment is found to be incorrect.
