The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for the grant of anticipatory bail in case registered vide FIR No.176 dated 21.06.2022 under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC registered at P.S. Sector 65, Gurugram, Haryana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 07.07.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 07.07.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 07.07.2022 is made absolute.
