The prayer in the present petition for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents No.4 and 13 from harassing or interfering in the peaceful life of the petitioners.

It is stated that respondent No.4 to 13 are giving death threats to the petitioners due to which the petitioners are facing grave danger and imminent threat to their life and liberty. The petitioners lives are stand still and a lot of mental harassment and threatening have been meted out to the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

Precisely, in the context of aforesaid relief, petitioners have approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka by way of representation dated 20.05.2023 (Annexure P-3), but no action has been taken thereon. He submits that petitioners would be satisfied if their representation dated 20.05.2023 is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sarabjit Singh Cheema, DAG,
Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and on a perusal of the paper book, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to look into the representation dated 20.05.2023 (Annexure P-3) filed by the petitioners and if necessary to take appropriate action on the same, as per law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of one month.
