The petitioners have filed the present petition before this Court with a prayer to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 and not to harass the petitioners for any false criminal complaint.

The status report by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur was filed on behalf of the official respondents and the same was taken on record.

Learned State counsel has submitted that after performing the marriage, the petitioners are not living in their house at village Sibbo Chak, P.O. Hajipur, District Hoshiarpur because Saudagar Singh, father of petitioner No.1 Narinder Kaur had registered a case against petitioner No.2 at Police Station Indora Himachal Pradesh. Further, petitioner No.2, namely, Sanjeev Kumar was living at the village Bakrarwa, P.S. Indora, District Kangra, even Saudagar Singh had lodged FIR No.122 dated 09.06.2022, under Section 363

IPC at Police Station, Indora, District Kangra against petitioner No.2. As per the directions of the Court at Kangra, petitioner No.1 has been sent to Nari Niketan, Dharamshala, Himachal Pradesh and she was living there. Even the police, who has recorded the statement of Sanjiv Kumar and the same had been annexed with the status report as Annexure R1/T, wherein he had categorically stated that he apprehends no danger to his life from anyone and he did not require any police protection at present and he is living in ancestral house with his parents i.e. at village Bakrarwa, H.P.

In view of the above, there is no necessity of passing further orders in the instant petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
