Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.0081 dated 09.04.2022 under Sections 420/120-B of IPC and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983, Police Station Division No.5, Police Commissionerate Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).

Vide order dated 06.07.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 06.07.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harbhajan Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 23.09.2022 and his further

investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 06.07.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
