The present writ petition has preferred for the issuance of an appropriate writ especially in the nature of mandamus in the context of providing Pharmacists certificate to the petitioner for which the petitioner has already submitted the necessary forms as well as fee to the office of respondents.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that petitioner has completed the pharmacy course of 02 years in the month of October, 2022. Provisional certificate of degree has already been issued to the petitioner which has been appended along with the present petition as Annexure P-3. He further submits that the application submitted by the

petitioner for issuance of certificate of pharmacists/pharmacy is pending with the respondents since 29.10.2022. He contends that in this regard, a legal notice dated 10.05.2023 (Annexure P-5) has been sent by the petitioner, however, till date no decision has been taken thereupon. He further contends that, at this juncture, he would be satisfied in case the respondent-authorities are directed to look into the legal notice and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1/State and Mr. Vivek Saini, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3, and they have no objection to the aforesaid prayer being granted..

Accordingly, with the consent of the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and the respondent No.2 is directed to take note of the legal notice dated 10.05.2023 (Annexure P-5) sent by the petitioner and to pass a reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law and preferably within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
