Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing orders dated 08.06.2021 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) vide which respondent No.3 has removed the petitioners from service after attaining the age of 58 years.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that during pendency of the writ petition, both the petitioners have attained the age of 60 years and have retired from service. He submits that to this extent, writ petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

Counsel submits that few months salary due to the petitioners has not been paid.

In case, any grievance still survives, liberty is granted to the petitioners to move a representation before the competent authority, who will look into it and pass an administrative order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of representation.
