PARMATMA SINGH AND OTHERS V/S. RANDHIR SINGH AND OTHERS.

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In response to the notice, Parmatma Singh and Jasmail Kaur, appellants 1 and 2 respectively, have put in appearance along with Manjit Singh and Kuldeep Singh. All the four have placed on record photocopies of their Aadhaar Cards for identification. Appellants, who came present, stated that appellant No.3-Rani Kaur widow of Surjit Singh has since remarried but her daughter, namely, Sukhpreet Kaur, then minor, is living with appellants 1 and 2 being her grandparents and that they have settled the matter with appellant No.3 and she has no objection if the entire enhanced amount is paid to appellant No.1-Parmatma Singh S/o Sajan Singh, for & on behalf of all the claimants. They have undertaken to place on record affidavit of appellant No.3-Rani Kaur in that behalf.

As agreed, as per statements of the appellants 1 and 2 appearing in person as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.5,50,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. As per the statement of appellants 1 and 2, appearing in person, the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1-Parmatma Singh S/o Sajan Singh, for & on behalf of all the claimants, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque in the sum of Rs.5,50,000/- favouring appellant No.1-Parmatma Singh S/o Sajan Singh, with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 01.04.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants may collect the cheque/draft from the office of the Lok Adalat on furnishing the affidavit of appellant No.3-Rani Kaur Wd/o Surjit Singh. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the appellant(s).

Appeal stands disposed of.
