This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise the wages of the petitioner at the rate of Rs.6500/- w.e.f. 01.03.2013, Rs.11,000/- w.e.f. 01.03.2017, Rs.12,100/- w.e.f. 01.03.2018 and Rs.14,300/- w.e.f. 01.03.2019 in view of the orders dated 20.05.2013, 31.05.2018 and 12.06.2019 (Annexures P-3 to P-5).

2. Learned State counsel has pointed out that the petitioner has given an affidavit (Annexure R-1) to the effect that he has resigned from GRP Unit and thus, he wishes to withdraw the present writ petition and does not want to claim anything from the department.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he has no instructions regarding the said affidavit, but he seeks to withdraw the

present writ petition with liberty to move an application for revival of the same in case the petitioner still wants to pursue the present petition.

4. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
