1. This petition is filed impugning appellate order dated 18.02.2016 releasing the accused (respondents) on probation and directing to pay compensation of Rs. 10,000/- to each injured.

2. Brief facts of the case are that the FIR was registered at the instance of the petitioner alleging that in an incident that took place on 23.05.2005, the accused inflicted injuries to the complainant party. The accused were convicted vide judgment dated 08.05.2014 and by order of sentence dated 12.05.2014 to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of six months.

3. In appeal, the appellate Court released the respondents on probation subject to furnishing of probation bonds in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- each. The respondents were further directed to pay compensation amount of

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing for some time restricts his prayer that the compensation awarded to the injured is on the lower side.
5. Learned counsel for the respondent on instructions submits that to settle the dispute, (buy peace of mind) and to put an end to the litigation respondents volunteer to give an additional compensation of Rs. 5000/- to each of the injured.
6. The offer made by counsel for the respondent is accepted by the counsel for the petitioner on instructions.
7. The petition is disposed of subject to respondents’ paying Rs. 5000/- as compensation to the each injured within six weeks from today.
8. On failure of the respondents to pay the compensation within the stipulated time, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition.
