The petitioner has filed this second petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 313 dated 17.11.2020, registered under Sections 21(C), 29 of the NDPS Act, Sections 7(2)(13) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel draw the attention of this Court towards Para 20 of the order dated 13.02.2023 passed by a Coordinate Bench in CRM-M-34206-2021 titled as 'Amritpal Singh Vs. State of Punjab' and other connected cases and the copy of the same was also handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner in the Court. Para 20 of the order is as under:-

*“20. Petitioner-Kamalpreet Singh is also not named in the FIR but
Kamalpreet Singh was found in the company of Balkar Singh*

against whom there was specific disclosure statements as regards his involvement. When Balkar Singh and Kamalpreet Singh were arrested, a pistol alongwith ammunition and an amount of Rs. 8 lacs was recovered from their car, which could point towards the complicity of the petitioner. As such, the petition on behalf of Kamalpreet Singh merits dismissal at this stage.”

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition, at this state.

Dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.
