[1] This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the official respondents No. 1 to 4 for registration of a case under appropriate sections of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, against the private respondents No. 5 and 6.

[2] As per the complaint, dated 01.06.2022 (Annexure P-19), the petitioner had given an application to the Director General of Police, Punjab (respondent No. 2), with a request that matters pertaining to her matrimonial dispute with respondent No. 5, Nitin Lamba, be transferred to Chandigarh, which are stated to be pending at the Khanna Police and the Fatehgarh Police, on the ground that no action is being taken on the complaint dated 03.11.2021 submitted by the father of the petitioner.

[3] Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Charanjit Singh, submits that the investigation is complete and the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has already been presented before the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Khanna, on the basis of the complaint given by the father of the petitioner.

[4] Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take appropriate action for transfer of cases at Chandigarh.

[5] Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

[6] Pending miscellaneous application (s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
